Sunday, December 25 THE NATIVITY OF OUR LORD AND GOD AND SAVIOR JESUS CHRIST.

Note: Holy day of obligation.

Bright vestments. Festal Service for Nativity, including proper Antiphons, Entrance Hymn and Immos. Instead of Trisagion, take *"All those who have been baptized..."* Dismissal of the Feast.

Scripture readings for the Nativity:

Epistle: Galatians [4:4-7].

Gospel: Matthew [2:1-12].

Note: There is no fasting until leave-taking of the Theophany.

Monday, December 26

SYNAXIS OF THE MOST HOLY THEOTOKOS; Commemoration of the Holy and Just Joseph, Spouse of the Holy Theotokos, King David; James. Brother of the Lord according to the Flesh; and the Holy Hieromartyr Euthymius, Bishop of Sardis.

Bright vestments. First Nativity Antiphon; Usual Third Antiphon with the refrain of the Second Nativity Antiphon *"Save us, Son of God, born of a virgin..."*; Tropar of the Nativity; GLORY/NOW: Kondak of the Nativity. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of the Nativity. Instead of *"It is Truly right..."* take Hirmos of the Feast. Festal Dismissal.

Scripture readings of the Feast:

Epistle: Hebrews [2:11-18].

Gospel: Matthew [2:13-23].

Tuesday, December 27 Postfeast of the Nativity

The Holy Apostle, Protomartyr Archdeacon Stephen; Our Venerable Father and Confessor Theodore the Branded.

Bright vestments. Follow *Typikon* for December 26.

Scripture readings of St. Stephen:

Epistle: Acts [6:8-15; 7:1-5 & 47-60].

Gospel: Mathew [21:33-42].

Wednesday, December 28 Postfeast of the Nativity

The Holy Twenty Thousand Martyrs Burned in Nicomedia.

Bright vestments. Follow *Typikon* for December 26.

Scripture readings for Wednesday:

Epistle: Hebrews [5:11-6:8] (29th Week after Pentecost).

Gospel: Mark [11:23-26] (30th Week after Pentecost).

Thursday, December 29 Postfeast of the Nativity

The Holy Fourteen Thousand Infants Slain for Christ's Sake in Bethlehem of Judea by Herod; and Our Venerable Father Marcellus, hegumen of the Monastery of the Sleepless Ones.

Bright vestments. Follow *Typikon* for December 26.

Scripture readings for Thursday:

Epistle: Hebrews [7:1-6] (29th Week after Pentecost).

Gospel: Mark [11:27-33] (30th Week after Pentecost).

Friday, December 30 Postfeast of the Nativity

The Holy Virgin Martyr Anysia; and Our Venerable Father Zoticus, presbyter and friend of orphans.

Bright vestments. Follow *Typikon* for December 26.

Scripture readings for Friday:

Epistle: Hebrews [7:18-25] (29th Week after Pentecost).

Gospel: Mark [12:1-12] (30th Week after Pentecost).

Saturday, December 31 Leave-taking of the Nativity

Our Venerable Mother Melania the Roman.

Note: New Year's Eve

Bright vestments. Follow *Typikon* for December 26.

Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of the Saturday after the Nativity. Instead of *"It is Truly right..."* take Hirmos of the Feast. Festal Dismissal.

Scripture readings of the Saturday after the Nativity:

Epistle: 1 Timothy [6:11-16].

Gospel: Matthew [12:15-21].

Civil Holiday: New Year's Day.

Liturgy of St. Basil the Great. Bright Vestments.

Bright vestments. Tone 4. Matins Gospel VII.

Resurrection Tropar (Tone 4); Tropar of Circumcision; Tropar of St. Basil; GLORY: Kondak of St. Basil; NOW: Kondak of Circumcision. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of the Sunday before the Theophany; Circumcision and of St. Basil. Instead of *"It is truly right..."* take *"In you O woman..."*

Scripture readings for the Circumcision:

Epistle: Colossians [2:8-12].

Gospel: Luke [2:20-21; 40-52].

Monday, January 2 Prefeast of Theophany

Our Holy Father Sylvester, Pope of Rome.

Bright vestments. Tropar of Prefeast; GLORY/NOW: Kondak of Prefeast.

Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of Monday.

Scripture readings of the Thirtieth Monday:

Epistle: Hebrews [8:7-13].

Gospel: Mark [8:11-21].

Tuesday, January 3 Prefeast of Theophany

The Holy Prophet Malachi; and the Holy Martyr Gordius.

Bright vestments. Tropar of Prefeast; GLORY/NOW: Kondak of Prefeast. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of Tuesday.

Scripture readings of the Thirtieth Tuesday:

Epistle: Hebrews [9:8-10; 15-23].

Gospel: Mark [8:22-26].

Wednesday, January 4 Prefeast of Theophany

The Synaxis of the Seventy Holy Apostles; and Our Venerable Father Theoktistus, Hegumen of Cucume Monastery in Sicily.

Bright vestments. Tropar of Prefeast; GLORY/NOW: Kondak of Prefeast. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of Wednesday.

Scripture readings of the Thirtieth Wednesday:

Epistle: Hebrews [10:1-18].

Gospel: Mark [8:30-34].

Thursday, January 5 Vigil of Theophany

The Holy Martyr Theopemptus, Bishop of Nicomedia and Theonas; and Our Venerable Mother Syncretica of Alexandria.

Note: Today is a day of fasting (meat may not be eaten; however, eggs and dairy products are permitted).

Early in the morning: Dark vestments. Royal Hours are celebrated.

In the afternoon: Vespers with the Liturgy of St. Basil the Great; instead of *"It is truly right"* take *"In you, O woman full of grace ..."*

Scripture readings for the Vigil of Theophany:

Epistle: 1 Corinthians [9:19-27].

Gospel: Luke [2:1-18].

After the Ambo Prayer: Great Blessing of Water.

In the evening: Great Compline with Lita.

Friday, January 6

THE HOLY THEOPHANY OF OUR LORD AND GOD AND SAVIOR JESUS CHRIST.

Note: Holy day of obligation.

Bright vestments. Festal Service for Theophany, including proper Antiphons, Entrance Hymn and Immos. Instead of Trisagion – *"All those who have been baptized..."* Dismissal of the Feast.

Scripture readings for Theophany:

Epistle: Titus [2:11-14; 3:4-7].

Gospel: Matthew [3:13-17].

After the Ambo Prayer: Great Blessing of Water.

Saturday, January 7 Postfeast of Theophany

The Synaxis of the Holy and Glorious Prophet, Forerunner and Baptizer John.

Saturday after the Enlightenment

Bright vestments. First Antiphon of the Feast; regular Third Antiphon with the refrain of the Second Antiphon of Theophany; Proper Entrance Hymn; Tropar of the Feast; Tropar of Saint John the Baptist; GLORY: Kondak of Saint John the Baptist; NOW: Kondak of the Feast. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of the Saint and the Feast. Instead of *"It is truly right..."* take Hirmos of the Feast.

Scripture readings for the Saturday after the Enlightenment:

Epistle: Ephesians [6:10-17].

Gospel: Matthew [4:1-11].

Sunday, January 8 Sunday after the Enlightenment

Postfeast of Theophany.

Our Venerable Father George the Chozebite; Our Venerable Mother Domnica; and the Holy Confessor Emilian.

Bright vestments. Tone 5. Matins Gospel VII.

Sunday Antiphons. Resurrection Tropar (Tone 5); Tropar of the Feast; GLORY: Sunday Kondak; NOW: Kondak of the Feast. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of Sunday after Theophany.

Scripture readings for the Sunday after the Enlightenment:

Epistle: Ephesians [4:7-14].

Gospel: Matthew [4:12-17].

Monday, January 9 Postfeast of Theophany

The Holy Martyr Polyuctus of Melitene in Armenia.

Bright vestments. Bright vestments. First Antiphon of the Feast; regular Third Antiphon with the refrain of the Second Antiphon of Theophany; Proper Entrance Hymn; Tropar of the Feast; GLORY/NOW: Kondak of the Feast. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of the Feast. Instead of *"It is truly right..."* take Hirmos of the Feast.

Scripture readings of the Thirty-First Monday:

Epistle: Hebrews [11:17-23].

Gospel: Mark [9:42-10:9].

Tuesday, January 10 Postfeast of Theophany

Bright vestments. Follow *Typikon* for Monday, January 9.

Bright vestments. First Antiphon of the Feast; regular Third Antiphon with the refrain of the Second Antiphon of Theophany; Proper Entrance Hymn; Tropar of the Feast; Tropar of the Saint GLORY: Kondak of the Saint; NOW: Kondak of the Feast. Prokimen, Alleluia Verses and Communion Hymn of the Feast and the Saint. Instead of *"It is truly right..."* take Immos of the Feast.

Gospel: Matthew [11:27-30].

Thursday, January 12 Postfeast of Theophany

The Holy Martyr Tatiana, Deaconess.

Bright vestments. Follow *Typikon* for Monday January 9.
